Course Outlines

Each Certificate is delivered face to face, 20 hours per week over 2 days, 8:30am to 7:30pm.

There are 18 teaching weeks and up to 4 weeks holidays; total – 22 weeks.

Intakes are every week apart from scheduled and public holidays.

Entry Requirements

Credit Transfer
