The CUA20215 Certificate II in Creative Industries (Media) is designed for domestic and overseas learners who are interested in developing skills in multimedia platforms, enhancing creativity and productivity when dealing with media products. The course engages learners with observation of portfolios and creative thinking to gain the ability to produce and create media products. This qualification will provide you with the practical skills and knowledge to perform a range of mainly routine tasks in the creative industry sector. You will learn to develop and apply creative arts industry knowledge and apply critical thinking techniques.

Entry Requirements

International students are required to have IELTS 5.5, having partial command of the English language, coping with overall concepts in most situations. EIP will provide an entrance test which assesses a student's language and computer literacy and skills, prior to commencing the course.

EIP does not accept applications from students under 18 years of age.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

There are no RPL arrangements for this course at EIP.

Credit Transfer

You may be eligible for credit transfer if you have previously undertaken training through a Registered Training Organisation. Credit transfer may be granted for one or more units or a full certificate level. Three major factors need to be considered: How current the qualification is, does the matter previously studied map to the current version of the course or unit, and if the training was undertaken with an Australian Registered Training Organisation. If you think you may be eligible for credit transfer you will need to provide the following: A certified copy of the original statement of attainment and/or certificate is to be provided for a credit transfer.
